

## PHOTO RALLY

Grade level : Cycle 3 Elementary

This activity aims at helping youth quickly identify examples of concepts explored in the SHINE workshop.

### Goal

Allow students to illustrate with images the concepts observed in the SHINE workshop.

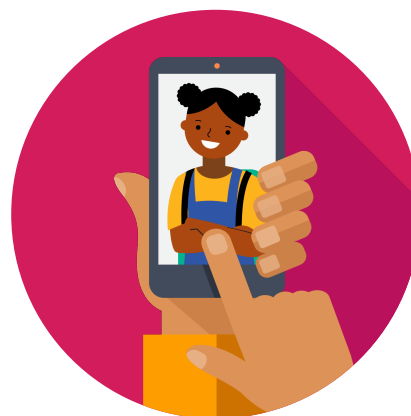
### Material

- The list of concepts to illustrate (see following page);
- Tablet or phone to take pictures;
- Plan for the students to be able to circulate throughout a section of the school.

### Procedure

Divide the students into small teams and provide each team with the list of concepts to illustrate. They can either mime the concept and photograph themselves or take a picture of an object or a place that depicts the concept. Afterwards, present the pictures of each team to the whole class. The team with the most concepts illustrated wins.

**Additional information:** The list of concepts contains suggestions. Do not hesitate to include or replace certain items to have this activity better suit the needs of your students. You can also divide the list among the teams to have the final result be a collaboration of all the teams coming together.
